ASHRAE Participates in Congressional Data Centers Briefing

On December 8, Marcus Hassen, Chair of the ASHRAE Standard 90.4, *Energy Standards for Data Centers* Project Committee, presented at a Congressional briefing entitled "The Data Center Boom: Growth & Sustainability Considerations." Hosted by the Green Building Initiative, the session explored the rapid growth of U.S. data centers, along with the economic opportunities, infrastructure challenges, and sustainability considerations shaping this critical sector. Hassen discussed how ASHRAE Standard 90.4 and the resources of ASHRAE Technical Committee 9.9 have become foundational to how data centers are designed, operated, and optimized for resilience, sustainability, and performance, and in guiding stakeholders to navigate instances where tradeoffs around these issues emerge.
